

- 4 The rest will have the opportunity to display a poster during ESVB on **May 15^h – 17th**
- 5 Three winners for best presentations and one winner for best poster will be crowned during the conference dinner on **May 16th**

Young Researcher Prize (YRP) - Abstract Submission Guidelines ESVB 14th Biannual Meeting Strasbourg, France

1. General information

The Poster and Young Researcher Prize (YRP) sessions aim at presenting the research works of **young PhD and/or fellows to support and boost** research in the field of vascular biomaterials. All subject will be considered but clinical relevance is mandatory. **This year Topics:**

- Device Biomechanics
- Biomaterial updates
- Robotics, Navigation
- The occluded aortic and aorto-iliac bifurcation
- Veins
- Patient safety and prediction of implantation
- Branches and windows arch and thoracoabdominal aorta

The abstract submission is open to vascular trainees (MSc, PhD, Students) and scientific researchers in the field of biomaterial and vascular surgery who **should be less than 35 years old**.

35 abstracts will be selected for a 180s presentation during the Translational Research Symposium.

3 presentations will be selected for a 5 mins oral presentation during ESVB congress.

1 poster will be awarded.

50 posters will be selected to be displayed in the congress venue.

- **Abstract submission closes: March 1st, 2025**
- **Early bird registration Deadline: March 14th, 2025**

Abstract and submission forms must be submitted by following the rules in section 6b.

2. Abstract layout

- An English language abstract in the terminology familiar to specialists.
- The title should not exceed 200 characters (including space and punctuation)
- The text should be succinct and substantive (200 to 500 words max).
- **Reference should be included in the Vancouver style**
- The abstract should contain figures and table (up to 2)

3. Abstract format

a. Abstract title:

Title	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- A title not exceeding 200 characters (including space and punctuation)- The title should be informative, concise and intelligible.
Affiliation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Present the authors' affiliation addresses below the names.- Provide the full postal address of each affiliation, including the country name and, if available, the e-mail address of each author.

b. Abstract body: The following format must be followed:

Introduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- The introduction should summarize and introduce the research in a manner understandable and of interest to specialists and non-specialists. <p>The introduction should be a brief section designed to inform of the relevance of the research that leads to a statement of the problem that is being addressed.</p>
Methods	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- The methods section should contain sufficient information to be able to understand the experimental design, the analytical techniques and the statistics used in the study.
Results	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- The results section describes but does not interpret.- The presentation data may be either chronological to correspond with the methods or in the order of most to least important.
Conclusion	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- The conclusions section should provide only conclusion of the study directly supported by the results, along with implications for clinical practice, avoiding speculation.
References	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- References should be limited to 5.- References should be typed in the Vancouver style.

4. Illustrations format

Up to two graphics, tables and images can be included in the abstract.

- Size the illustrations close to the desired dimensions of the published version.
- Illustration format: **.pdf, .jpeg keep to a minimum of 300dpi in MCVB format.**
- Illustration must be sent via a link (dropbox, wetransfer, google, etc.)

For a borrowed illustration, a credit line should follow the legend; **we need the permission of the publisher to insert it in the book.**

5. Sessions type

a. All abstract submitters should be prepared to present the abstract as an oral communication or/and poster presentation.

b. The abstract review committee reserves the right to assign a different presentation format from the one selected by the presenting author.

c. Oral Young Researcher Prize Session (YRP): **Thirty-five (35) revised abstracts** will be selected directly for oral presentation during YRP session on May 15th.

Scorers will select **the three (3) best oral communications.**

d. Those **three (3) best oral presenters** will have to present their work during the ESVB session on Friday, May 16th, 2025.

e. Poster Prize session: Authors of abstracts selected for poster presentation will be required to set up their poster in a dedicated area in accordance with any communicated deadline. **Posters selected for presentation** will be selected will be included in the Poster Prize session.

The scoring of the Posters will take place on Friday May 16th (exact timing will be announced in due time). We strongly encourage authors to be present next to their poster to answer any potential questions from the Scorers. Scorers will select **the best poster**.

6. Submission

a. Submitting Author: The person submitting the abstract should be the author presenting the work

b. Send his abstract to communication@gepromed.com

Please note that you will need to register for the conference at your own expense to present your works.

7. Review and Acceptance

c. The scientific review committee will review the abstracts according to the relevance to ESVB, objectivity of statements, suitability of methods, conclusions confirmed by objective results, scientific value, originality of work and overall impression. **The abstracts will be selected in a blinded fashion.**

d. The notification of acceptance or rejection will be sent out by February 6th, 2025. If the presenting author is unable to present the abstract, one of the co-authors can present in his/her place. An email from the presenting author indicating the change is requested and must be received by the ESVB organization by April 10th.

8. Awards, registration and expenses

Of the three oral presentation selected the first will be award 1500€, the second 1000€ and the third 500€. The selected poster will be awarded 300€.

All presenting authors of selected abstracts will need to register for the ESVB 14th bi-annual Meeting in due time. Please remember that early registration is more economic. The deadline for Early Bird Registration is March 15th, 2025. The ESVB will not cover costs incurred in submitting an abstract or poster, or for travel and accommodation costs for presenting authors.

The ESVB is looking forward to receiving your abstract for its 14th Meeting in Strasbourg, France!
